Kelly Williamson holds a Bachelor's degree in performance with Distinction from McGill University, and a Master's degree in performance from l'Université de Montreal. Her past teachers include Timothy Hutchins and Denis Bluteau. She also played in master classes for Geoffrey Gilbert and Peter Lloyd, and has studied privately with Toshio Takahashi, founder of the Suzuki method for flute.

Following her graduation from McGill, Kelly was the recipient of an Arts Study Grant from the government of Alberta, and was the winner of the East York Symphony's Young Artists' competition. She worked as a freelance musician in Montreal for many years, playing as a chamber musician and soloist with orchestra, with various stage productions, and participating on several CDs. She was a regular member of Trio Ambiance and a frequent clinician in local schools, and adjudicator at music festivals. She relocated to London, ON in June 2006.

Kelly Williamson teaches using the Suzuki approach. She was appointed a Registered Suzuki Teacher Trainer in flute in May 2006. Kelly has been invited to teach at Suzuki workshops and institutes in Canada, the US, Peru, Argentina, Colombia, and Tanzania, and is the flute columnist for the American Suzuki Journal. She has regularly contributed to the Suzuki community at the local and international levels, and currently serves as flute representative for the Suzuki Association of Ontario.

- 1. To perform you are required to fill out a *Class Admission Form* and hand this along with your music to the adjudicator or secretary just before you perform. Your music will be returned when the certificates are awarded at the end of your class. Please make sure that your music was returned. Class Admission Forms will be available where you enter. There is also a copy at the end of this document which you can print and complete ahead of time.**
- 2. Performance of solo categories by memory is not required for scholarships or awards, but is highly encouraged. Exception: All performances in the Shield Competition must be by memory.**
- 3. While students will not be penalized for longer compositions, the suggested maximum length of compositions is *5 minutes for Junior Classes and 10 minutes for Senior Classes*. The adjudicator reserves the right to hear only part of the composition.**
