Adjudicator: Philip Candelaria:

Philip Candelaria received his Bachelor of Music degree in Music History from the University of British Columbia in Vancouver, B.C. He then completed his Master's degree in guitar performance, studying with Aaron Shearer at the Peabody Conservatory of Johns Hopkins University in Baltimore, Maryland. This was done through the generous support of the Canada Council.

Candelaria made his professional debut performing at "Guitar '78", Toronto's 2nd international guitar festival. Philip went on to win several national music competitions in Canada, the USA, and was also the first North American to win the "dégre excellence" at the Bartoli International Guitar Competition in France.

Since 1980, Candelaria has headed the guitar department at the Cambrian College School of Music. He was also a guitar instructor at Laurentian University for 27 years and currently teaches at Ottawa University.

Mr. Candelaria has adjudicated throughout Ontario, in B.C., Manitoba, Quebec, and at the Ontario Guitar Competitions, the Canadian National Guitar Competition, and twice at the National Guitar Festival "Liliana Pérez Corey" in Santiago, Chile (1998, 2005). In 2004, Candelaria was a member of the international Jury panel for the Music Competition "Dr. Luis Segal" in Viña del Mar, Chile and in 2007 was the guitar adjudicator for the national finals of the Canadian Music Festivals.

An experienced clinician, Philip enjoys working with guitar students of all ages in workshops and masterclasses. Candelaria has taught at many festivals around the world, and recently has been giving lessons and classes via broadband web casting to Canadian locations.

Candelaria has made four solo recordings on the Cambrian, Palladium, and Centrediscs labels. These have been described as "dazzling" (Canada Music Magazine), "distinguished" (High Fidelity Magazine - USA), and "masterful" (GFA Soundboard - USA). A founding member of the Canadian Guitar Quartet, Philip Candelaria has also made three recordings with the CGQ. The second of these, "Les Scènes de Quartiers", received the Golden Trillium award for best instrumental album of 2005.

Candelaria's current season includes solo concerts in Canada and concerts in Austria, Canada, Germany, Mexico, and the USA with the Canadian Guitar Quartet, and performances with the Guitars Alive Trio.

1. All selections are OWN CHOICE.
 2. In Age categories Junior refers to participants 15 years and under and Senior to age 16 and over.
 3. In Grade categories Junior refers to selections at Conservatory Grade 6 and under and Senior to Conservatory Grade 7 and over (no minimum age restrictions).
 4. Graded selections are to be chosen from the Royal Conservatory of Music or Conservatory Canada syllabus.
 5. Solo indicates one person on stage
 6. Performance by memory is encouraged for all solo categories and will be taken into consideration for awards and scholarships.
 7. All performances in Shield Competition MUST be by memory.
 8. ORIGINAL MUSIC only must be given to adjudicator - no photocopies.
 9. While students will not be penalized for longer compositions, the suggested maximum length of compositions is *5 minutes for Junior Classes and 10 minutes for Senior Classes..* The adjudicator reserves the right to stop performances.
 10. Classes are not open to Adults, Professionals or Post-Secondary students unless otherwise indicated. Please see Rules and Regulations, Section D - 'Eligibility'.
 11. "Various Fretted" refers to all fretted instruments *except for guitar* - such as banjo, mandolin & ukelele. In the ensemble classes "other instruments" refers to non-fretted such as violin or flute.
